



Honduras Report

This month, I returned from a ministry trip to Tegucigalpa, Honduras. (it took a few days, but I can now pronounce it).

I was scheduled for only a weekend, but extended the trip for a week. It was planned that I bring a four hour course for third year bible students, but **first and second year classes joined in and we spent 12 hours training them in spiritual gifts.** As the week progressed we fit in as much ministry as possible; speaking to women's groups, ministry staff, pastors, and congregations.

The ministry was especially effective because



the expectancy was high and the receptivity very strong. Many received the Holy Spirit each day, demons were expelled and healing was instantaneous.



The classroom instruction on healing gifts was accompanied by excellent demonstrations. As we taught the students step by step we prayed for a pastor's wife who was suffering from Asthma. **As she took a deep breath her lungs were**

opened.

At the same moment another student in the meeting began rejoicing. She testified that at the moment the spirit of infirmity left the pastor's wife, her right lung began burning and was opened at the same time! God was showering us with grace. **The classes became so electrified with the presence of God that students were jumping to their feet to testify. (I really like this job!)**

Our work among the churches also produced much fruit. The missionaries, pastors and workers and church members were all greatly strengthened.



To sum up, I sensed the entire trip was ordained by the Lord. The work was very worthy of financial support from Lifeline International. **Thanks to our supporters we also met a big need of bibles for the new church plants. Thank you.**

The atmosphere in the classroom had become electric with the presence of God. It was as if Jesus were walking around the room casually instructing us and demonstrating for us.



The girl in the picture just happened to be in the front row as I was illustrating something about the flow of God's virtue. **I was unaware of the girl's sickness but she was instantly healed as I took her hands.**

She testified of how the fire of God had come upon her mid-section immediately and healed her of a terrible condition that made her too ill to eat. Her husband stood to confirm her testimony and tell us about the terrible ordeal she had been through. As he was talking she became very hungry. So I told him to run to the kitchen and get her something to eat. She received the food with no discomfort. **Her pain disappeared and never returned!**

The next day, I heard the rest of the story. She had 7 miscarriages, a phony hysterectomy and then an 8th miscarriage. Her intestinal tract was so messed up she could not eat without pain. Her insides were a mess.

As I was leaving class, she stopped us and told us she had gone to the Doctor for tests and an examination. **In the picture she is holding the doctor's report of a clean bill of health!**

Being aware of our own weaknesses, there are times when we do not feel or think we are very useful to the cause; our part doesn't seem to be very significant. It is not uncommon to feel empty or faithless as we approach ministry engagements. These are emotions that must be ignored.

It is when we press though the inadequate feelings of the moment and stand before the need that we find ourselves surprised by His ability to break through our weakness.

When we represent Him, His presence comes and His virtue begins to flow. And when you see the impact it has, It is then you realize once again... "Wow, God can even use little ole me!"

It's such an honor to carry His presence and to minister to others. It's an addiction for which there is no cure!
